HOUSE BILL NO. 2

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-THIRD SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "To appropriate the sum of \$ 135,100.00 for legislative expenses; and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. That the sum of \$135,100.00 or so much thereof as may be found necessary is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of salaries to persons employed by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska during the present session and for other such necessary legislative expenses, said sums to be apportioned according to the following schedule:

(1) For the salaries of the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate, \$26.00 per day for 72 days, which includes 11 days service in preparation of Journal; one Assistant Clerk of the House of Representatives, \$12.00 per day for 60 days; one Assistant Secretary of the Senate at \$22.00 per day for 60 days; the sum of.....\$ 6,552.00

(2) For the salaries of the Sergeant-At-Arms of the House of Representatives, \$18.00 per day for 60 days, and the Sergeant-At-Arms of the Senate, \$18.00 per day for 60 days; the sum of.....\$ 2,160.00

(3) For the salaries of the following employees of the Senate for 60 days; one Expressing Clerk and one Enrolling Clerk

1 at \$18.00 per day; one Bill Clerk and six Typists at \$17.00 per
2 day; one Judiciary Clerk, one Finance Committee Clerk, two
3 stenographers at \$19.00 per day; one mimeograph operator and two
4 messengers at \$16.00 per day, and one doorkeeper and one watch-
5 man at \$15.00 per day; the sum of.....\$ 18,540.00

6 (4) For the salaries of the following employees of the
7 House of Representatives, for 60 days, four stenographers at
8 \$19.00 per day; one Enrolling Clerk and one Engrossing Clerk
9 at \$20.00 per day; one mimeograph operator, one Bill Clerk,
10 one Press Reader and seven typists at \$17.00 per day; one Mail
11 and File Clerk and two messengers at \$16.00 per day; one doorman
12 and one watchman at \$15.00 per day; the sum of.....\$ 21,600.00

13 (5) For the salaries of the Chaplain of the House of
14 Representatives, for 60 days at \$5.00 per day; and for the
15 Chaplain of the Senate, 60 days at \$6.00 per day; the sum
16 of.....\$ 720.00

17 (6) For the payment of additional services rendered by
18 the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Rep-
19 resentatives of the Territory of Alaska during the regular session
20 the sum of \$400.00 and this money is to be equally divided.

21 (7) For the payment of compensation to such janitors
22 and clerks as are necessary to clean, care for and keep in
23 proper order the rooms occupied by the Legislature at this session,
24 the sum of.....\$ 3,000.00

25 (8) For the payment of necessary telephone service for
26 use of the Legislature during the present session, the sum
27 of.....\$ 88.00

28 (9) For the preparing of the Senate and House Journals,
29 and the printing and binding of the Session Laws and advance

1 sheets; and for printing and furnishing stationery and other
2 printing for the use of the Legislature during the present
3 session, the sum of.....\$ 20,000.00

4 (10) For the purchase of mimeograph paper, typewriting
5 paper, stencils, carbons and such other material and supplies
6 as may be necessary for the use of the Legislature during the
7 present session, the sum of.....\$ 6,300.00

8 (11) For the payment of per diem in lieu of subsistence
9 at a rate of \$50.00 per day for the members of the Legislature,
10 60 days each for regular members of both Houses and 71 days for
11 the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House, the sum
12 of\$ 49,960.00

13 (12) For postage allowance of \$50.00 to be paid to
14 each member of the House and Senate, as the estimated amount
15 necessary to defray costs of mailing, telegraphing and otherwise
16 communicating with constituents during this session, the sum
17 of.....\$ 2,000.00

18 (13) For a Contingent Fund to be divided equally by
19 House of Representatives and the Senate for use in defraying cost
20 of extra mailing of a more nature and hiring of additional help
21 in case of other contingencies and same to be drawn on by the
22 authority of the Speaker of the House of Representatives or
23 President of the Senate, respectively, the sum of.....\$ 4,000.00

24 Sec. 2. The monies hereby appropriated shall be paid by
25 warrants drawn on the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon
26 vouchers approved by the President of the Senate and the Speaker
27 of the House of Representatives.

28 Sec. 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this
29 Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval,
