For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to an immediate appropri-

ation for salaries and expenses of the

Tennessee Plan Senators and Representative;

and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The sum of \$187,935.41, or so much thereof as

12

may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the

13

Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the payment

14

of salaries and expenses of the Alaska Tennessee Plan Senators and

15

Representative for the period ending March 31, 1959, according

16

to the schedule set forth below; Provided, however, that any

17

monies heretofore paid over by the Alaska Statehood Committee to

18

effect any of the expenses authorized and listed in the items

19

below, with the exception of that item designated as "Public

20

Relations and Miscellaneous", shall reduce the sums allowed here-

21

in and the amount reduced shall remain in the general fund:

1. Rentals \$ 9,600.00

2. Salaries -- (\$54,000.00)

Per Diem -- (\$43,800.00) 97,800.00

4. Stages 5,000.00

6 Section 2. Per-diem will be allowed at the rate of sixteen  
7 dollars (\$16.00) per day for each electee when away from the city  
8 in which he has his home. Fractional parts of a day will be de-  
9 termined in accordance with Territorial law.

10 Section 3. Each electee shall be entitled to receive a base  
11 salary not to exceed nine thousand dollars (9,000.00) per annum.

12 Section 4. The electees shall choose from among them a  
13 certifying officer, who shall be bonded in the amount of  
14 \$10,000.00, conditioned among other things upon the prompt and  
15 faithful accounting of all monies appropriated herein. The  
16 premium upon said bond shall be payable from the item designated  
17 above as "Public Relations and Miscellaneous". He shall prepare  
18 and sign all vouchers and, together with necessary supporting  
19 documents, shall forward them to the Department of Finance for  
20 payment. He shall also maintain such accounting records and  
21 reports as shall be prescribed by the Department of Finance.

22 Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and  
23 this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the  
24 date of its passage and approval.

1 to March 31, 1959 and the Alaska Tennessee Plan Senators and  
2 Representative are not seated, the Director of Finance may  
3 terminate at anytime thereafter all financial obligation of the  
4 Territory of Alaska under this Act; provided, that such termi-  
5 nation shall require the approval of a majority of the members  
6 of the Legislative Audit Committee.

7 Section 6. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and  
8 this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the  
9 date of its passage and approval.
