10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Article VI, Ch. 82, SLA 1955, is hereby amended  
12 by adding a new Sec. 4 to read as follows:

A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to Duties and Powers of  
7 the Director of the Employment Security  
8 Commission; amending Article III, Chapter 5,  
9 ESIA 1955; and setting an effective date,

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 311 of Article III, Chapter 5, ESIA 1955,  
12 is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 Sec. 311. DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE DIRECTOR OR TEMPORARY  
14 ACTING DIRECTOR. It shall be the duty of the Director  
15 to administer this Act in accordance with the provisions of  
16 Section 306, and he shall employ such persons, including a  
17 Deputy Director, make such expenditures, require such re-  
18 ports, make such investigations, and take such other action  
19 as he deems necessary or suitable to that end. The Director  
20 is authorized to delegate his powers and duties to the Deputy  
21 Director or to a responsible employee of the agency at such  
22 time as he may be absent from his office. The Deputy Direc-  
23 tor shall also assume all the duties and powers of the Direc-  
24 tor at such time as that office is vacant. In the absence of  
25 a full Commission, Director or Deputy Director, the senior  
26 member of the Commission, determined from the date that his  
27 oath of office is filed with the Department of Finance, is  
28 authorized to appoint a temporary acting Director who shall  
29 assume all duties and powers ordinarily vested in the Director.

1 Section 2. This Act shall take immediate effect and be in  
2 force from and after its passage and approval or upon its be-  
3 coming law without such approval, and it is so enacted.
