5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska Motor Vehicle  
7 Act (Ch. 124, SLA, 1951) and amending Sec.  
8 3 (1), 4, (4), and 5 (3) thereof, and  
9 declaring an emergency,

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1, Sec. 3 (1) of Ch. 124, SLA 1951, is amended by  
12 adding subsection (c) to read as follows:

13 (c) Any such vehicle owned by a dealer and held for resale  
14 which is driven or moved upon a highway with the dealer's  
15 demonstration registration plates attached and while operated  
16 by duly authorized representative of the dealer in the  
17 ordinary course of trade of such dealer or by a potential  
18 customer of such dealer during actual test or demonstration of  
19 such potential customer or by a purchaser from such dealer  
20 for a period not to exceed seven days from the date of sale.

21 Sec. 2, Sec. 4 (4) of Ch. 124, SLA 1951, is amended to read  
22 as follows:

23 (4) SPECIAL TAX FOR DEALERS. Upon the application for the  
24 first set of dealer's demonstration registration plates there  
25 shall be paid a tax in the amount of \$15.00, and for each  
26 additional set, \$7.50. Plate so obtained shall not be used  
27 on any one vehicle for more than thirty consecutive days.  
28 Upon any sale or other transfer of such vehicle by a dealer,  
29 such demonstration plates shall remain with the dealer,

1 except that the dealer may authorize the purchaser to use the  
2 plates for a period of not to exceed seven days from the  
3 date of sale.

4 Sec. 3, Sec. 5 (3) of Ch. 124, SLA 1951, is amended to  
5 read as follows:

6 (3) TEMPORARY PERMIT. The commissioner in his discretion  
7 may grant a temporary permit to operate a vehicle for which  
8 application for registration and issuance of certificate of  
9 title has been made. When a vehicle has been sold by a dealer  
10 or and the dealer is unable to furnish to the purchaser, there-  
11 of the documents required by the purchaser to make formal  
12 application for registration and issuance of certificate of  
13 title, the dealer shall furnish a certificate so stating  
14 to the buyer; the buyer shall, within seven days from the  
15 date of the purchase, apply to the Commissioner for a temp-  
16 orary permit to operate the vehicle, which application shall  
17 be accompanied by the certificate of the dealer; the Commis-  
18 sioner shall issue the permit and the permit shall be effective  
19 for a period of 30 days from the date of issuance. All appli-  
20 cations for a temporary permit shall be accompanied by a  
21 fee of \$1.00.

22 Sec. 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this  
23 Act shall take effect from and after its date of passage and  
24 approval.
