6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the annual minimum
7 remuneration of municipal magistrates;
8 amending Sec. 16-1-58, ACLA 1949; and
9 establishing an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 16-1-58, ACLA 1949 is amended to read as
12 follows:

13 Sec. 16-1-58. _____ Manner of nominating and electing;
14 Remuneration. Nomination and election of municipal mag-
15 istrates shall be in the same manner as provided for other
16 elected officers of the city and the remuneration of the
17 office SHALL BE DECLARED BY ORDINANCE, BEFORE THE ELECTION;
18 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT IN ALL CITIES OF THE FIRST CLASS
19 HAVING A POPULATION IN EXCESS OF THREE THOUSAND (3000)
20 PERSONS, THE MINIMUM REMUNERATION SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN
21 ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,800.00) PER ANNUM.
22 It may be increased at any time by the common council of any
23 city, but shall not be decreased between elections, unless
24 the remuneration of all municipal employees is simultaneously
25 and proportionately decreased. The provisions of Section
26 16-1-55, ACLA 1949, shall not be applicable to the office
27 of municipal magistrates from and after the effective date
28 hereof.

29 Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect on March 1, 1957.
