For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to charging administrative
7 costs for the collection and administration
8 of certain earmarked funds; and declaring
9 an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11

Section 1. The Territorial Treasurer, unless prohibited by

12

Federal law or regulation, shall, at the effective date of this

13

Act and thereafter, transfer into the General Fund from each

14

special Territorial fund which is made up in whole or in part of

15

earmarked monies collected from taxes imposed for specific purposes

16

and administered by any agency of the Territorial Government, ten

17

percentum of the unencumbered portion of the special fund for the

18

purpose of defraying the cost to the Territory for collecting and

19

for administering such monies; Provided, however, that any monies

20

collected and earmarked for school purposes or for Teacher's Re-

21

tirement fund shall not be charged or deducted.

22

The Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska, upon the receipt of

23

all earmarked monies hereafter, shall divert ten percentum of such

24

monies to the General Fund.

25

Sec. 2. This Act shall take immediate effect and be in force

26

from and after its passage and approval or upon its becoming law

27

without such approval, and it is so enacted.
