For an Act entitled: "An Act pertaining to salaries, qualifica-
7 tions, and numbers of teachers, principals,
8 vice-principals, head teachers, teachers-
9 in-charge, and superintendents in schools
10 in the Territory of Alaska; repealing and
11 re-enacting Sections 37-6-1 and 37-6-2,
12 ACILA 1949, as last amended by Chapter 176,
13 Session Laws of Alaska 1955; repealing and
14 re-enacting Section 37-6-3, ACILA 1949;
15 amending Sections 37-6-4, 37-6-5, and
16 37-6-6, ACILA 1949; and establishing an
17 effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 37-6-1, ACILA 1949, as last amended by
Chapter 176, Session Laws of Alaska 1955, is hereby repealed and
re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 37-6-1. TEACHERS' SALARY SCALE BY DIVISIONS.

The school boards of school districts in the Territory of
Alaska and the Territorial Board of Education as the opera-
ting school board for schools outside school districts shall
pay regularly qualified teachers employed by them and with
public school experience in Alaska allowable in accordance
with the Rules and Regulations of the Territorial Board of
Education a salary which shall be not less than that set

1 DIVISIONS. The school boards of school districts in the
 2 Territory of Alaska and the Territorial Board of Education
 3 as the operating school board for schools outside school
 4 districts shall pay regularly qualified superintendents
 5 employed by them and with public school administrative
 6 experience in Alaska allowable in accordance with the Rules
 7 and Regulations of the Territorial Board of Education a
 8 salary which shall be not less than that set forth in the
 9 following scale:

29 The amount of \$500 shall be added to each step of the First

1 Division Scale.

2 Second and Fourth Judicial Divisions

4 Longitude. The amount of \$200 shall be added to each step
5 of the First Division Scale.

6 Section 3. Section 37-6-3, AGLA 1949, is hereby repealed
7 and re-enacted to read as follows:

8 Section 37-6-3. AMOUNTS ESTABLISHED ABOVE SALARY SCALE
9 FOR PRINCIPALS, VICE-PRINCIPALS, HEAD TEACHERS, AND TEACHERS-
10 IN-CHARGE. The school boards of school districts in the
11 Territory of Alaska and the Territorial Board of Education
12 as the operating school board for schools outside school
13 districts shall pay regularly qualified principals, vice-
14 principals, head teachers, and teachers-in-charge employed
15 by them a salary which shall be not less than the allowable
16 salary on the Teachers' Salary Scale for the Judicial
17 Division in which employed plus the following amounts in all
18 Judicial Divisions:

19 Principals - \$600 above Teachers' Scale
20 Vice-Principals - \$300 above Teachers' Scale
21 Head Teachers - \$300 above Teachers' Scale
22 Teachers-in-Charge - \$150 above Teachers' Scale

23 Section 4. Section 37-6-4, AGLA 1949, is hereby amended to
24 read as follows:

25 Section 37-6-4. REFUNDS REIMBURSEMENT TO SCHOOL
26 DISTRICTS: POSITION ON SALARY SCHEDULE AS DETERMINING:
27 EMPLOYMENT AT A RATE HIGHER THAN THE MAXIMUM SALARY SCALE.
28 REFUNDS Reimbursement from the Territory to school districts
29 shall be made at the percentum rate NOW prescribed by law,

1 and be made in the same manner; provided, however, that the
2 REFUND reimbursement allowed on each employed teacher's
3 OR , superintendent's, principal's, vice-principal's, head
4 teacher's, or teacher-in-charge salary shall be determined
5 by the TEACHER'S OR SUPERINTENDENT'S salary scale position
6 of the employed UPON THE SALARY SCHEDULE as established by
7 the Territorial Board of Education; and provided further,
8 that no REFUNDS reimbursement shall be made to any school
9 district in Alaska on any salary paid which is less than the
10 MINIMUM scale or any amount which is in excess of the
11 MAXIMUM scale established HEREIN by law. Nothing in this
12 Act shall be construed as prohibiting the employment of a
13 teacher, OR superintendent, principal, vice-principal, head
14 teacher, or teacher-in-charge at a higher rate than the
15 MAXIMUM WAGE scale specified in this Act 7, either by a
16 school district board or the Territorial Board of Education
17 as the operating board for schools outside school districts.
18 Section 5. Section 37-1-5, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to
19 read as follows:

20 Section 37-6-5. STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS; FILING;
21 CONTENTS. A statement of the qualifications of each teacher
22 and superintendent employed by the Territorial Board of
23 Education or by a school district shall be filed with the
24 Commissioner of Education; such statement shall set forth the
25 credits earned in college, normal school or university, and
26 the number of years of teaching experience both in Alaska and
27 elsewhere 7 in such form and manner as may be prescribed by
28 the Commissioner of Education.

29 Section 6. Section 37-6-6, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to

1 read as follows:

2 Section 37-6-6. DETERMINATION OF NUMBER OF TEACHERS,
3 SUPERINTENDENTS, PRINCIPALS, VICE-PRINCIPALS, AND HEAD
4 TEACHERS FOR WHICH DISTRICT ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT. The
5 maximum number of teachers, superintendents, principals,
6 vice-principals, and head teachers for which any school
7 district shall be entitled to reimbursement shall be deter-
8 mined by the Territorial Board of Education.

9 Section 7.— Funds to carry out the provisions of this Act may
10 be appropriated in the General Appropriations Bill of the Alaska
11 Legislature.

12 Section 8. This Act shall become effective July 1, 1957.
