6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to fish trap license
7 taxes; and amending paragraph (h) of
8 Subsection 7th of Section 35-1-11,
9 ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 11,
10 SLA 1949."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Paragraph (h) of Subsection 7th of Section
13 35-1-11, ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter II, SLA 1949, is
14 hereby amended to read as follows:

15 "(h) Fish traps: hand driven or stake traps located
16 on tide lands, \$300.00 per annum. Pile driven or float-
17 ing traps, \$1200.00 per annum, so called dummy traps in-
18 cluded. THAT AN ADDITIONAL TAX ON FISH CAUGHT IN ANY ONE
19 PILE DRIVEN OR FLOATING TRAP BE LEVIED AS FOLLOWS:

20 THE FIRST 15,000 FISH BE TAX FREE;

21 FROM 15,000 TO 50,000, 5¢ PER FISH;

22 FROM 50,000 TO 100,000, 10¢ PER FISH;

23 FROM 100,000 TO 150,000, 15¢ PER FISH;

24 FROM 150,000 TO 200,000, 20¢ PER FISH;

25 AND ALL FISH OVER 200,000, 25¢ PER FISH. 7

26 In addition to the above ~~any~~ any person, firm
27 or corporation occupying and operating more than three
28 traps shall pay an additional \$600.00 per trap for the fourth
29 to tenth trap inclusive, and an additional \$1200.00 per trap

3 ditional \$2000.00 for all traps over fifty."

For the purposes of this Subsection, "hand driven or stake traps" means any fixed device located on tide lands, operated for the purpose of impoundment of salmon, which at extreme low low tide incapable of fishing. Pile driven or floating traps means any fixed device operated for the purpose of impoundment of salmon, which extends completely or in part into deeper water than extreme low low tide.
