3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

4 TWENTY-THIRD SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "Use of fuels indigenous to Alaska in
7 Territorial buildings and to which the
8 Territory supplies funds along the rail-
9 belt."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. The Legislature recognizes these facts:

12 (a) Incentives to industry in Alaska are necessary
13 to the well being of the people and the use of fuels in-
14 digenous to the Territory will add to the economic
15 development of the country, and

16 (b) The governmental agencies of Alaska should lead
17 the way in promoting local economy.

18 Therefore, looking to the present and the future
19 this statute is enacted.

20 Section 2. All schools, offices or other buildings now
21 existing, or hereafter to be constructed, belonging to the Terri-
22 tory of Alaska, and all buildings toward which the Territory
23 provides funds for construction, operation or maintenance, located
24 along the Alaska railbelt from and including the City of Anchorage
25 on the south to and including the northern terminal at the City of
26 Fairbanks and all extensions therefrom, shall hereafter be
27 required to use fuels indigenous to Alaska, or to have their
28 source of heat derived from such fuel.
