6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to provide for the recovery of
7 civil damages from a parent or guardian due
8 to the malicious or wilful destruction of
9 property by minors."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Civil liability of Parent: Penalties. Any
12 person, individual, partnership, municipal corporation, private
13 corporation, association, village, school district or any religi-
14 ous or charitable organization, whether incorporated or unincorp-
15 orated, shall be entitled to recover damages in a civil action
16 in an amount not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and
17 court costs, in a court of competent jurisdiction, from either
18 parent or both parents, or the legal guardian or person having the
19 legal custody of any unemancipated minor under the age of 18 years,
20 who maliciously or wilfully destroys property, real, personal or
21 mixed, belonging to such person, individual, partnership, municipi-
22 pal corporation, private corporation, association, village, school
23 district or any religious or charitable organization, whether
24 incorporated or unincorporated; provided, however, that a
25 Territorial agency or its agents, including any persons working
26 in or responsible for the operation of any foster, receiving, or
27 detention home, or children's institution, shall not be subject
28 to such liability for the acts of unemancipated minors placed in
29 their charge or custody.
