A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending Section 51-2-33 ACLA 1949,  
7 as amended by Chapter 57, SLA 1949, as  
8 amended by Chapter 106, SLA 1951 by increas-  
9 ing the amount of payments authorized in the  
10 Aid to Dependent Children program."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

12 section 1. Section 51-2-33 ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter  
13 57, SLA 1949 and Chapter 106, SLA 1951, is hereby amended to read  
14 as follows:

15 Sec. 51-2-33. AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE. The amount of  
16 assistance which shall be granted for any dependent child,  
17 and the relative with whom the dependent child is living,  
18 shall be determined by the Welfare Department with due regard  
19 to the resources and necessary expenditures of the family and  
20 the condition existing in each case and shall be sufficient,  
21 when added to all other income and support available to the  
22 child, to provide such child and relative with reasonable sub-  
23 sistence compatible with decency and health; providing, how-  
24 ever, that the amount of assistance granted shall not exceed  
25 eighty dollars (\$80.00) /SIXTY DOLLARS (\$60.00) when there  
26 is a relative and one child, and where there is more than one  
27 such child, the amount allowed for the relative and first  
28 child shall not exceed eighty dollars (\$80.00) /SIXTY DOLLARS  
29 (\$60.00) and the amount for each additional child shall not

1 exceed thirty dollars (\$30.00).
