A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to permit the employment of
7 females in bona fide food establishments
8 serving intoxicating liquor; requiring
9 establishments employing females to obtain
10 permit; and declaring an emergency."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. All employees serving intoxicating liquor in an
13 establishment operating under a Beverage dispensary license shall
14 be male citizens of the United States, over the age of 21 years
15 and of good moral character. Provided, however, that female
16 citizens over the age of 21 of good moral character regularly
17 employed as waitresses in an establishment operating under a
18 Beverage dispensary license may serve intoxicating liquor together
19 with food, if such establishment: (1) regularly service meals
20 as a major and substantial part of its business, (2) applies
21 for an receives a permit to employ females from the Board of
22 Liquor Control. The serving of sandwiches, burgers, hot-dogs,
23 snacks or similar food items shall not qualify an establishment
24 to employ females under this proviso.

25 Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and
26 this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the
27 date of its passage and approval.
