2 HOUSE BILL NO. 132

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the levy and
7 collection of taxes assessed and
8 levied by Independent School
9 Districts; amending Section 37-3-53
10 ACIA 1949; and setting an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Sec. 37-3-53 ACIA 1949, is hereby amended to
13 read as follows:

14 Section 37-3-53. BOARD TO PREPARE AND PRESENT BUDGET:
15 PROPORTIONING FUNDS BETWEEN CITY AND OUTSIDE TERRITORY:
16 LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES: DELINQUENT TAXES: EXEMPT-
17 IONS.

18 On or before the first day of May each year the school
19 board shall determine the amount of funds needed for all
20 school purposes for the following school year beginning
21 on the first of July and ending on June 30, the year
22 following, or such other fiscal year as the school board
23 deems advisable. It shall, at the same time, determine
24 the proportion of the funds to be raised within the city
25 and the proportion of the funds to be raised outside
26 the city based on assessed valuations. It shall then
27 present the budget to the city council for its approval
28 or rejection of the city's share of the budget. The
29 city council shall on or before (AT) its first meeting in

1 May determine the amount it shall set aside for school
2 purposes as its share of the school expense for the school
3 year and transmit this information to the school board.

4 The Board shall then determine the share to be paid
5 by that portion of the district lying outside the city
6 and levy the rate outside accordingly and this rate shall
7 be the same as it is necessary to raise the city's share
8 within the city. The city council shall transmit to
9 the treasurer of the school board on the first day of
10 each quarter of the fiscal school year one-fourth of its
11 share of the budget. The assessor or other collection
12 agent appointed by the school board shall collect the
13 taxes due from all taxable property outside the city
14 limits but within the district in such installments
15 and at such times for each fiscal year as the school
16 board may by resolution direct. (THE ASSESSOR APPOINTED
17 BY THE SCHOOL BOARD SHALL, ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST OF
18 OCTOBER OF EACH YEAR COLLECT ONE-HALF OF THE TAXES DUE
19 FROM ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS BUT
20 WITHIN THE DISTRICT AND ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST OF MARCH
21 OF EACH YEAR, HE SHALL COLLECT THE OTHER HALF.) The
22 penalties for the non-payment of taxes outside the city
23 but within the district shall be the same as is fixed by
24 the city council for the non-payment of taxes within the
25 city and the rates of interest on delinquent taxes shall
26 also be the same. Residents of the Independent School
27 District living outside of the city limits shall be allowed
28 the same exemption of taxes as is permitted within the city.
29 Sec. 8. This Act shall take immediate effect and be in

1 force from and after its passage and approval or upon its be-
2 coming law without such approval, and it is so enacted.

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
