6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting the use of professional  
7 titles on ballots; amending Sec. 38-5-6,  
8 ACLA 1949, and Sec. 38-4-4, ACLA 1949."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Sec. 38-5-6, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to  
11 read as follows:

12 Sec. 38-5-6. ARRANGEMENT OF NAMES ON BALLOT: DIS-  
13 TINGUISHING MARKS: GATHERING AND NUMBERING PRINTED BALLOTS.  
14 The names of candidates for each office upon the ballot and  
15 under the heading designating each official position upon  
16 the ballot to be used in voting, shall be first arranged in  
17 alphabetical order of the family names of such candidates.  
18 No professional title or abbreviation thereof, either as a  
19 prefix or suffix, shall be printed on any ballot.

20 Sec. 2. Sec. 38-4-4, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read  
21 as follows:

22 Sec. 38-4-4. PRIMARY BALLOTS. There shall be but one  
23 form of ballot used in the primary election and it shall  
24 contain the names of all candidates and shall indicate their  
25 party affiliation. The names shall be grouped according to  
26 offices and within each office alphabetically rotated accord-  
27 ing to the initial letter of the last name of each candidate,  
28 without regard to party affiliation. No professional title  
29 or abbreviation thereof, either as a prefix or suffix, shall
