6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the pay periods of Terri-
7 torial officers and employees; repealing and
8 re-enacting Sec. 11-3-7, ACLA 1949; and de-
9 claring an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 11-3-7, ACLA 1949, is hereby repealed and re-
12 enacted to read as follows:

13 Sec. 11-3-7. TIME FOR AND COMPUTATION OF PAYMENT: DE-
14 Ductions FOR ABSENCE. Officers and employees of the Territory
15 shall be paid for such periods and at such times as may be
16 prescribed by the Director of Finance. Any person entering
17 or quitting the service of the Territory shall receive com-
18 pensation for the actual number of days (including holidays)
19 or hours that he was in such service. The salary of all offi-
20 cers and employees shall be prescribed on an annual basis.
21 Compensation per hour shall be determined by dividing the
22 annual salary by 1950 hours, the normal work hours per year;
23 compensation per day shall be determined by multiplying the
24 hourly rate by 7-1/2 hours, the normal work hours per day.
25 One day's pay shall be deducted for each day an employee is
26 absent without leave.

27 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall take immediate effect
28 and be in force from and after its passage and approval or upon its
29 becoming law without such approval, and it is so enacted.
