6 For an Act entitled: "An Act pertaining to Vital Statistics,
7 Recording; amending Sec. 26 of Ch. 119,
8 SLA 1949 as amended by Ch. 86, SLA 1951."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Sec. 26 of Ch. 119, SLA 1949, as amended by
11 Ch. 86, SLA 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 Sec. 26. COMMISSIONER TO RECORD AND TRANSMIT CERTI-
13 FICATES: FEES. It shall be the duty of every United States
14 Commissioner within Alaska to record every birth, death and
15 marriage certificate presented to him for record; and said
16 United States Commissioner shall receive as compensation for
17 his services in recording each of said certificates the fees
18 prescribed by the Attorney General of the United States for
19 similar services performed by United States Commissioners
20 acting as ex-officio recorders. The United States Commis-
21 sioners of each recording district shall on or before the
22 tenth day of each month transmit to the Registrar of Vital
23 Statistics all original certificates of birth, death and
24 marriage filed with him for the preceding calendar month;
25 and he shall at the same time submit to the Registrar an
26 account of fees due for recording certificates of birth and
27 death during the preceding calendar month, which account
28 shall be audited by the Registrar, and if approved by him,
29 shall be paid from the funds of Alaska. For each certificate

of birth, death or stillbirth occurring within Alaska, and not previously recorded, properly completed, signed, and filed with the United States Commissioner within a time limit prescribed by the Registrar, the person signing and filing such certificate shall be entitled to a fee of one dollar (\$1.00), upon presentation to the Registrar of a statement therefor, [DULY VERIFIED BY THE U. S. COMMISSIONER WITH WHOM SUCH CERTIFICATE WAS FILED.] This does not apply to such certificates filed by a physician or nurse in the course of his or her duties as prescribed in this Act.
