6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to divorce; imposing a
7 limitation upon date of trial and entry
8 of decree; and conferring a duty upon the
9 court to specify in the decree on the
10 subject of remarriage."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. No divorce case shall be tried, nor any decree
13 of divorce entered therein, until the complaint in such action
14 shall have been on file for ninety days, and until ninety days
15 shall have elapsed from the date of service of summons on the
16 defendant: Provided, that in cases where summons by publication
17 is had, the date of first publication of summons shall be
18 equivalent to the date of service of summons in other cases for
19 the purposes of this section.

20 Section 2. It shall be the duty of the court granting a
21 divorce to specify in the order for judgement whether either or
22 both of the parties shall be permitted to marry and, if so, when,
23 and the court shall have jurisdiction to modify the decree of
24 divorce at any time so as to permit one or both of the parties
25 to marry as in his discretion he shall deem it right.
