4 TWENTY-THIRD SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting the operation of any
7 device, except music machines, by persons
8 under the age of twenty-one; limiting the
9 number of gaming devices per location;
10 prescribing a penalty; and amending Sec.
11 49-3-5, ACLA 1949."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. PURPOSE. The business of importing, operating
14 and maintaining coin-operated amusement devices, coin-operated
15 gaming devices or slot machines is effected with a public inter-
16 est and is a proper subject of regulation. Abuses which have
17 arisen and may arise from the accumulation of numbers of such
18 machines in a single location require such regulation under the
19 police powers of the Territory of Alaska.

20 Sec. 2. Sec. 49-3-5, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read
21 as follows:

22 Sec. 49-3-5. OPERATION BY PERSONS UNDER TWENTY-ONE
23 ~~EIGHTEEN~~: LOCATION NEAR SCHOOLS. The operation of any
24 device, except music machines, covered by this Act by any
25 person under the age of twenty-one ~~EIGHTEEN~~ shall not be
26 permitted by any operator or other person having such de-
27 vice in his charge. Excepting music machines, no machine
28 shall be placed, used, located or operated within a radius
29 of one hundred yards of any school building.

1 Sec. 3. LIMITING NUMBER OF GAMING DEVICES. No more than
2 four coin-operated gaming devices, as defined in Sec. 3 (b)
3 hereof, shall be maintained or permitted in any one place,
4 premise or location.

5 Sec. 4. PENALTY. Any person violating any provision of
6 this Act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction
7 thereof shall be fined not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00)
8 Dollars or imprisoned in jail for a period of not more than
9 sixty (60) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
