8 Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the Territory of  
9 Alaska, in Twenty-Third regular Session assembled, respect-  
10 fully submits that:

11 WHEREAS, Under Section 107 of H. R. 10660 of the 84th  
12 Congress, known as THE FEDERAL AID HIGHWAY ACT FOR ALASKA,  
13 a highway program for Alaska is to be established; and

14 WHEREAS, Under these provisions, a proposed system or  
15 systems of roads must be agreed upon by the Governor of Alaska,  
16 the Territorial Highway Engineer of Alaska, and the Secretary  
17 of Commerce for the United States; and

18 WHEREAS, For a continuing and orderly program of highway  
19 construction in the Fourth Division of Alaska, to its vast  
20 mining areas and otherwise, careful consideration must be given  
21 to a sound priority schedule;

22 NOW THEREFORE, Your Memorialist respectfully petitions  
23 that the highways to be constructed in the Fourth Judicial  
24 Division follow to every extent the below submitted priority  
25 schedule;

26 First priority - Fairbanks - Nenana - Healy

27 Second priority - Livingood - Eureka - Rampart - Tanana

28 Third priority - Fairbanks - Chena Hot Springs

29 Fourth priority - Healy - McKinley
