11 Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska,

12 in Twenty-third Regular Session assembled, respectfully submits

13 that:

14 WHEREAS, many residents, fishermen, and homesteaders of the

15 Seldatna, Alaska, area are in dire need of a road starting on the

16 south side of the Kenai River bridge and running in a west north-

17 westerly direction to the beach of Cook Inlet near the Libby,

18 McNeil and Libby cannery, a distance of about 10 miles, which

19 road would serve 65 homesteads, the cannery, and about 20 fishing

20 sites, and a continuation of said road running in a southerly

21 direction for ten miles along Cook Inlet, which road would serve

22 an additional thirty fishing sites; and

23 WHEREAS, said residents and homesteaders of the Seldatna

24 area have a great need for a road starting at the Kenai River

25 bridge on the north side of the river and running in a west and

26 northerly direction for a distance of approximately three and one-

27 half miles and connecting to the Kenai spur road in the vicinity

28 of Irville which road would serve approximately ten homesteads

29 and fifteen small tracts; and

1        WHEREAS, many residents of the Seldatna area sorely need a  
2 road starting at the Kenai River bridge and running in a north-  
3 easterly direction along the south side of the Kenai River for a  
4 distance of approximately three and one-half miles to and through  
5 the Public Service Site which is to be used as a public park,  
6 which road would provide access to said park, and in addition  
7 would serve 23 homesteads, 4 homesteads, and 4 private property  
8 owners,

9        NOW, THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the Legislature of the  
10 Territory of Alaska, in Twenty-third Regular Session assembled,  
11 respectfully urges the construction of said roads.
