8 HONORABLE A. F. GHIGLIONE, ACTING REGIONAL ENGINEER, REGION TEN,
9 BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS; THE HONORABLE IRVING REED, TERRITORIAL
10 HIGHWAY ENGINEER; THE TERRITORIAL BOARD OF ROAD COMMISSIONERS.

11 Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska,
12 in Twenty-third Regular Session assembled, respectfully submits
13 that:

14 WHEREAS, the agricultural and mineral development of that
15 area between Hope and Kenai, Alaska, along Cook Inlet, has been
16 seriously curtailed because of the lack of adequate overland
17 transportation in such area; and

18 WHEREAS, the completion of a road in this region would per-
19 mit travel between Hope and Kenai at a considerable saving in
20 miles and fuel over travel by the only existing route; and

21 WHEREAS, such road would further provide a means of evacuating
22 the residents of the populous Anchorage area in the event of a
23 crisis or calamity; and

24 NOW, THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the Legislature of the
25 Territory of Alaska in Twenty-third Session assembled, respectfully
26 urges the construction of said road.
