HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, in Twenty-Third Session assembled, that the Delegate to Congress from Alaska be respectfully requested to immediately introduce in the Congress of the United States legislation permitting the Territory of Alaska to create two judgeships having jurisdiction of the District Court for the District of Alaska, and to appoint judges to fill these positions through the method provided in the proposed Constitution of the State of Alaska, the Territory of Alaska to pay the salaries of these judges; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be sent to the Judiciary Committees of the House and Senate of the Congress of the United States, to the Attorney General of the United States, and to the Secretary of the Interior; and that these Committees and officials be and they hereby are respectfully urged to give this legislation the support and backing of their respective offices.
