HOUSE MEMORIAL NO. 1

THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-THIRD SESSION

TO THE ALASKA AERONAUTICS AND COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION AND THE
DIVISION OF AERONAUTICS FOR THE ALASKA AVIATION DEPARTMENT:

Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the
Territory of Alaska, in Twenty-third Session assembled, re-
spectfully represents that:

WHEREAS, the town of Kaltag, Alaska, is at the present
time without facilities for the landing of aircraft, other than
that of a sand bar, located across and up-stream of the Yu-
kon River from the main village, and

WHEREAS, the residents of Kaltag are greatly dependent
upon aircraft, not only for medical attention and personal
transportation but also for mail service and other supplies,
and,

WHEREAS, at certain seasons of the year it is impossible
to cross the river to the airstrip, and

WHEREAS, the construction of an adequate air strip on
the village side of the Yukon river would be of great ben-
efit and importance to the many residents of that area, and
would be a furtherance of the purpose and objectives of the
Alaska Aeronautics Act which is to provide for the protect-
ion of persons and promotion of safety in aeronautics by en-
couraging and developing a territorial system of airports:

NOW THEREFORE, Your Memorialist, the House of Represent-
atives of the Territory of Alaska, respectfully urges that
the Division of Aeronautics of the Alaska Aviation Department
