Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the
10 Legislature of the Territory of Alaska in Twenty-third Regular
11 Session assembled submits that:

WHEREAS, the community of Dillingham is the largest
13 population center in the Bristol Bay area; and

14

WHEREAS, it is the commercial center for more than 3,000
15 persons within its trading area; and

16

WHEREAS, the population is solely dependent upon air
17 service for transportation; and

18

WHEREAS, community leaders, U.S. Public Health Service
19 officials and others have testified before the Civil Aeronautics
20 Board stressing the need for scheduled DC-3 service between
21 Anchorage and Dillingham and Dillingham and Bethel; and

22

WHEREAS, Northern Consolidated Airlines has provided such
23 service to the community on a regular scheduled basis, contrib-
24 uting to the repair of the airfield, installation of runway
25 lights and electronic equipment to permit instrument landings;

NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialist, the House of Representa-
27 tives of the Territory of Alaska, in Twenty-third Session
28 assembled, respectfully urges the temporary certificate now held
29 by Northern Consolidated Airlines to operate between Anchorage

1 and Dillingham and Dillingham and Bethel, which is due to expire
2 March 10, 1957, be renewed and preferably on a permanent basis.
