Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Terri-

tory of Alaska, in Twenty-third Session assembled, respectfully

submits that:

WHEREAS, there is no existing road between the village of

11

Barrow and the immediate airport, a distance of 3½ miles; and

12

WHEREAS, there is a definite and dire need for a road to

13

connect the village of Barrow and the airport; and

14

WHEREAS, the fresh water lake is also located in the im-

15

mediate vicinity of said airport from which those persons in the

16

village of Barrow must secure their water supply; and

17

WHEREAS, the U. S. Mail must be transported between Barrow

18

and the airport several times each week; and

19

WHEREAS, during the tourist season the airlines must trans-

20

port visitors into the village three to four times per day by

21

various and sundry means; and

22

WHEREAS, a road would be utilized by the nearby construction,

23

Army, and Airforce personnel to avail themselves to the postal

24

and other services in the village; and

25

WHEREAS, such a road would greatly further the general wel-

26

fare of the village of Barrow;

NOW THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the House of Representativ-
