BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE TERRITORY

OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, substantial growth in the population of Alaska has

8

led to an increased market demand for agricultural commodities;

and

WHEREAS, the cost of shipping such commodities to Alaska

11

from the states has increased considerably in the past few years;

12

and

WHEREAS, these developments have heightened interest in

14

possible prospects for expanded agricultural land use in the Ter-

15

ritory, especially in areas adjacent to population centers; and

16

WHEREAS, the Western Kenai Peninsula is one such area which

17

has a high potential for use as agricultural land;

18

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representa-

19

tives of the Territory of Alaska that the University of Alaska

20

through its Agricultural Department, is hereby directed to

21

study the possibility of establishing an agricultural experi-

22

mental station on the Kenai Peninsula.
