A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska Motor Vehicle
7 Act; amending Sec. 1 of Ch. 124, SLA 1951;
8 as amended by Sections 1 and 2 of Ch. 59,
9 SLA 1953; and setting an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Section of Ch. 124, SLA 1951 as amended by
12 Secs. 1 and 2, Ch. 59, SLA 1953, is amended by adding subsection
13 (22) to read as follows:

14 N (22) "Special mobile equipment" shall be taken to
15 E mean and include every vehicle not designed or used primarily
16 W for the transportation of persons or property and incidentally
17 M operated or moved over a highway, including farm tractors,
18 A road construction or maintenance machinery, ditch-digging
19 T apparatus, well-boring apparatus, and non-self-propelled
20 T concrete mixers. The foregoing enumeration shall be deemed
21 E partial and shall not operate to exclude other such vehicles
22 R which are within the general terms of this section.

23 Sec. 2. Section 3 (1) of Ch. 124, SLA 1951, is amended
24 to read as follows:

25 (1) VEHICLES SUBJECT TO REGISTRATION -- EXCEPTION.

26 Every motor vehicle, trailer and semi-trailer when driven
27 or moved upon a highway shall be subject to the registration
28 provisions of this act except:

29 (a) Any such vehicle which is driven or moved

upon a highway only for the purpose of crossing such highway from one property to another.

(b) Any implement of husbandry which is only incidentally operated or moved upon a highway.

(c) Any special mobile equipment.

Sec. 3. This Act shall take immediate effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval, and it is so enacted.
