For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to adverse possession

against the Territory and any political sub-

division thereof; amending Sec. 58-7-6,

ACLA 1949; and setting an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 58-7-6, ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read

12 as follows:

Sec. 58-7-6. WHEN POSSESSION CONCLUSIVELY PRESUMED TO

14

GIVE TITLE. The uninterrupted adverse notorious possession

15

of real property under color and claim of title for seven

16

years or more shall be conclusively presumed to give title

17

thereto except as against the United States, the Territory

18

of Alaska or any political subdivision thereof.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take immediate effect and be in

20

force from and after its passage and approval or upon its be-

21

coming law without such approval, and it is so enacted.
