For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to dog control, authoriz-

ing reciprocal agreements between public

utility districts, incorporated cities, *N*

or other units of local government, and the

Department of Taxation, for the administra-

tion of dog control."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Cities, public utility districts, and other

14

political subdivisions of the Territory of Alaska are hereby

15

authorized to enter into contracts with each other and with the

16

Territory of Alaska, through the Territorial Tax Commissioner,

17

and to do whatever else may be necessary for the establishment

18

of an effective dog control authority, to operate within an

19

area to be defined in the contract. Such area may include that

20

land occupied by any combination of local government unit, as

21

well as other land outside such units.
