5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to provide for a loan of \$1,608,990.
7 to the Alaska National Guard for the con-
8 struction and equipping of community center-
9 armories on a three-to-one (3:1) basis with
10 the United States; providing for the repay-
11 ment thereof; and declaring an emergency."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. LOAN OF \$1,608,990. AUTHORIZED FOR CONSTRUCTING
14 AND EQUIPPING COMMUNITY CENTER-ARMORIES IN TEN (10) ALASKAN
15 COMMUNITIES. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund,
16 as a loan, the sum of \$1,608,990., to be transferred immediately
17 upon the passage of this Act to the "Territorial Military Fund" of
18 the Territorial Military Department for constructing and equipping
19 community center-armories in the following communities:

20	Anchorage	\$ 215,570.
21	Bethel	\$ 357,250.
22	Fairbanks	\$ 186,220.
23	Homer	\$ 63,450.
24	Juneau	\$ 287,500.
25	Ketchikan	\$ 134,500.
26	Nome	\$ 324,500.
27	Kodiak (Additions)	\$ 20,000.
28	Sitka (Renovation)	\$ 15,000.
29	Hoonah	\$ 5,000.

1 It is the intent of the Legislature that these monies be ex-
2 pended on a three-to-one (3:1) matching basis with the United
3 States for basic armories; however, where deemed necessary, the un-
4 matched portion of these monies may be expended for such additional
5 construction and equipment as may be essential to a complete
6 community center-armory.

7 Sec. 2. LOAN TO BE REPAYED FROM THE PROCEEDS OF BONDS. The
8 aforesaid loan is to be repaid to the General Fund as monies be-
9 come available from the issuance of bonds by the Territory under
10 authority of appropriate Territorial enabling legislation enacted
11 pursuant to Public Law 516, 84th Congress, Chapter 248, Second
12 Session.

13 Sec. 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this
14 Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of
15 its passage and approval.
