5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to provide for a loan to the Alaska
7 National Guard for the construction and
8 equipping of community center-armories on a
9 three-to-one (3:1) basis with the United
10 States; providing for the repayment thereof;
11 and declaring an emergency."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. LOAN AUTHORIZATION FOR CONSTRUCTING AND EQUIPPING
14 COMMUNITY CENTER ARMORIES IN THE TERRITORY. The Territorial
15 Military Department is hereby authorized to construct and equip
16 armories in Alaska on the authorized matching basis with the United
17 States, pursuant to Public Law 783, 81st Congress. Funds to carry
18 out the provisions of this Act may be appropriated in the General
19 Appropriations Bill of the Alaska Legislature as a loan to the
20 Territorial Military Department Fund of the Military Department
21 and to remain there until expended for constructing and equipping
22 community center armories in the Territory.

23 It is the intent of the Legislature that any money appropriat-
24 ed for this purpose be expended on a three-to-one (3:1) matching
25 basis with the United States for basic armories. However, where
26 deemed necessary, the unmatched portion of these monies may be
27 expended for such additional construction and equipment as may be
28 essential to a complete community center armory,

29 Sec. 2. LOAN TO BE REPAYED FROM THE PROCEEDS OF BONDS. The

1 aforesaid loan is to be repaid to the General Fund as monies be-
2 come available from the issuance of bonds by the Territory under
3 authority of appropriate Territorial enabling legislation enacted
4 pursuant to Public Law 516, 84th Congress, Chapter 248, Second
5 Section.

6 Sec. 3. EMERGENCY. An emergency is hereby declared to exist
7 and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the
8 date of its passage and approval.
