For an Act entitled: "An Act to provide for the refund of
7 contributions from the Teachers' Retirement
8 Fund to teachers who failed to file
9 a timely application while on approved
10 leave of absence during the period pro-
11 vided for in this Act; and declaring an
12 emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. RIGHT TO A REFUND. Any teacher who has lost
15 the right to a refund of retirement contributions to the
16 Teachers' Retirement Fund for failure to file a timely applica-
17 tion under the provisions of the Retirement Act of 1945 (Section
18 37-5-21, ASLA 1949, et seq., as amended and subsequently
19 repealed), and who was on an approved leave of absence status
20 from duty as a teacher in the Alaska Public School System, may
21 file for a refund as hereafter set forth. Provided, however,
22 that the length of such approved leave of absence (followed by
23 termination), when deducted from the number of months elapsing
24 from date of termination of "membership service" to the date of
25 written application for refund, does not exceed the limitations
26 established by the said Retirement Act of 1945.

Sec. 2. MANNER OF APPLYING FOR REFUND. Written applica-
28 tion for refund under the provisions of this Act, along with a
29 verification of the actual dates of approved leave of absence

1 shall be made to the Secretary of the Teachers' Retirement
2 System on or before July 1, 1958. §

3 Sec. 3. EMERGENCY. An emergency is hereby declared to
4 exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from
5 and after the date of its passage and approval.
