11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Sec. 49-2-21, ACLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 75,
13 SLA 1949, Ch. 21, SLA 1951, and Ch. 105, SLA 1953, is hereby
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Sec. 49-2-21. ENUMERATION OF PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT
16 POWERS. Each Public Utility District shall have succession
17 in its corporate name, may sue and be sued, including the
18 bringing of injunction proceedings, in its corporate name,
19 may adopt and use a corporate seal, which shall be judicially
20 noticed; make contracts to enforce or carry into effect any
21 authority herein granted; may purchase, lease or otherwise
22 acquire such real and personal property as it deems necessary
23 or convenient in the transaction of its business, and may
24 dispose of any [SUCH PERSONAL] property held by it, provided
25 that real property shall be disposed of in the manner pre-
26 scribed for disposal of real property by municipalities
27 in Sec. 16-1-31 Twentieth, ACLA 1949, as amended; *may extend →*
