6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to require professional and
7 technical services to be secured under
8 negotiated contract; amending Subsection (g)
9 of Sec. 48-5-2, ACLA 1949, as amended by
10 Ch. 80, SLA 1951, and Ch. 47, SLA 1955."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Subsection (g) of Sec. 48-5-2, ACLA 1949, as
13 amended by Ch. 80, SLA 1951, as amended by Ch. 47, SLA 1955, is
14 hereby amended to read as follows:

15 (g) The monies herein collected from the taxes on all
16 motor fuels, except the fuels named in subsections (e) and
17 (f) of this section, shall be covered into a special fund
18 in the Territorial Treasury to be known as the "Highway
19 Fund", and shall be expended by the Highway Engineer as
20 nearly as practicable in the Division where collected giving
21 due consideration to the need therefor, and be expended for
22 public roads, highways, trails, bridges, and ferries and
23 approaches and appurtenances thereto, including the acqui-
24 sition of necessary rights-of-way by purchase or otherwise.
25 It shall be the policy of all departments of the Territorial
26 government authorized to expend funds collected from taxes
27 imposed by this Act, to perform, whenever feasible, all
28 construction and/or reconstruction projects by contract after
29 such projects have been duly advertised for competitive bids

except that professional and technical services in connection therewith shall insofar as possible be secured under negotiated contracts or under [AS TO] advantageous arrangements with the Bureau of Public Roads [ALASKA ROAD COMMISSION] or political subdivisions and except in cases of emergency.
