For an Act entitled: "An Act to permit cities, towns, other

incorporated entities, or fire protection

groups to make Mutual Aid agreements for

fire protection purposes."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

N Section 1. Cities, towns, other incorporated entities,

12

E and other fire protection groups may organize mutual aid pro-

13

grams as follows: Cities, towns, other incorporated entities,

14

or fire protection groups may adopt ordinances or resolutions

15

M authorizing and permitting their respective fire departments,

16

A fire companies, emergency relief squads, fire police squads or

17

T fire patrols to go to the aid of another city, town, fire pro-

18

T tection district, protected by a fire protection group, or

19

E territory outside of any of the foregoing, and while in

20

R performance of extending such aid, the department, companies,

21

squads, and patrols and the members thereof shall have the same

22

immunities and privileges as if performing the same within

23

their respective cities, towns, incorporated area or territory.

24

Any such ordinance or resolution may authorize the head of the

25

fire department to extend such aid, subject to such conditions

26

and restrictions as may be prescribed therein. Any agreement

27

made under this amendment shall be effectuated in such a manner

28

that insurance rates shall not be increased nor shall such

29

agreement reduce the liability of any insurance company in the

1 event of a loss during the absence of men and equipment pur-
2 suant thereto.

3 Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and
4 this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the
5 date of its passage and approval.
