For an Act entitled: "An Act to permit cities, towns, other

7

incorporated entities, or fire protection

groups to make Mutual Aid agreements for

fire protection purposes."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Cities, towns, other incorporated entities, and

12

other fire protection groups may organize mutual aid programs as

13

follows: Cities, towns, other incorporated entities, or fire pro-

14

tection groups may adopt ordinances or resolutions authorizing and

15

permitting their respective fire departments, fire companies,

16

emergency relief squads, fire police squads or fire patrols to go

17

to the aid of another city, town, fire protection district, pro-

18

tected by a fire protection group, or territory outside of any of

19

the foregoing, and while in performance of extending such aid, the

20

department, companies, squads, and patrols and the members thereof

21

shall have the same immunities and privileges as if performing the

22

same within their respective cities, towns, incorporated area or

23

territory. Any such ordinance or resolution may authorize the head

24

of the fire department to extend such aid, subject to such condi-

25

tions and restrictions as may be prescribed therein. Any agree-

26

ment made under this amendment shall be effectuated in such a

27

manner that insurance rates shall not be increased nor shall such

28

agreement reduce the liability of any insurance company in the

29

event of a loss during the absence of men and equipment pursuant
