For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Chapter 66, SLA 1955,

pertaining to the office of the Fire

Marshal, defining offenses and pre-

scribing penalties; and declaring an

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Chapter 66, SLA 1955, is hereby amended by

13

adding the following section:

14

Section 10. Any person who shall violate any of the

15

provisions of this Act or the rules and regulations promul-

16

gated thereunder and from which no appeal has been taken

17

within thirty (30) days after the issuance of a final order,

18

shall severally for each and every such violation, be guilty

19

of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than

20

\$500.00 or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months

21

or by both such fine and imprisonment. Any person aggrieved

22

by the Fire Marshal's issuance of a final order may appeal

23

to the District Court within thirty (30) days after the

24

issuance of such an order. The imposition of one penalty

25

for any violation shall not excuse the violation or permit

26

it to continue; and all such persons shall be required to

27

correct or remedy such violations or defects within a reason-

28

able time and when not otherwise specified, each ten (10)

29

days that prohibited conditions are maintained shall

2 The application of the above penalty shall not be held  
3 to prevent the enforced removal of prohibited conditions.

4 Sec. 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this  
5 act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date  
6 of its passage and approval.
