of Ch. 111, SLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 35-2-143. BOARD OF EXAMINERS: MEMBERS, QUALIFICA-
TIONS AND TERMS: VACANCIES. There shall be a Territorial
board of engineers and architects examiners consisting of
nine members, to be appointed by the Governor. Said board
shall consist of three ~~TWO~~ civil engineers, one ~~TWO~~
mining engineer ~~is~~, two engineers from other branches of
the profession practiced in the Territory and three archi-
tects. At least four of the engineers and two of the archi-
tects serving on said board shall be engaged in private
practice. The term of office of any member who was engaged
in private practice at the time of his appointment, shall
terminate upon his leaving private practice. The terms of
office of board members serving immediately prior to the
effective date of this Act shall ~~expire on such effective~~
date, and the Governor shall appoint new members to the said
board as soon thereafter as is practicable. ~~The terms of~~
~~office as determined by the Governor of the first nine~~

1 M members of the board shall be as follows: The terms of
2 E office of two engineer members and one architect member
3 W shall expire January 1, 1959; the terms of two engineers
4 M and one architect shall expire January 1, 1961, and the
5 A terms of two engineers and one architect shall expire
6 T January 1, 1963. The Governor may make appointments from
7 T nominees recommended by recognized professional organiza-
8 E tions, or branches thereof, representing the respective
9 R professions licensed hereunder. Except as provided in this
10 Section, [T] the term of office for each member shall be
11 six years [FROM JANUARY FIRST OF THE YEAR APPOINTED]. The
12 Governor may remove any member of the board for misconduct,
13 incapacity or neglect of duty. Vacancies in the board
14 caused by death, resignation or removal from office shall
15 be filled by appointment by the Governor for the unexpired
16 term. Each member of the board shall be a professional
17 engineer or architect of at least five years active experience
18 and of recognized good standing in his profession and shall
19 have been a resident of this Territory for at least two
20 years immediately preceding his appointment. Each member
21 of said board shall also be a registered professional
22 engineer or architect. The members of the board shall
23 serve without compensation.
