6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to prohibiting employment  
7 discrimination; amending Subsection 5 of  
8 Sec. 3, Ch. 18, SLA 1953; and repealing and  
9 re-enacting Secs. 1 and 10 of Ch. 18, SLA  
10 1953."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Section 1 of Ch. 18, SLA 1953 is hereby repealed  
13 and reenacted to read as follows:

14 Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person,  
15 employer, employee, labor organization, employment agency  
16 or other person or persons to discriminate in the employment  
17 of any person because of race, religion, color or national  
18 origin.

19 Sec. 2. Subsection 5 of Section 3 of Ch. 18, SLA 1953 is  
20 hereby amended to read as follows:

21 5. The term "employer" does not include a club ex-  
22 clusively social, or a fraternal, charitable, educational or  
23 religious association or corporation, if such a club,  
24 association or corporation is not organized for private  
25 profit AND NOR DOES IT INCLUDE ANY EMPLOYER WITH LESS THAN  
26 TEN PERSONS IN HIS EMPLOYY.

27 Sec. 3. Sec. 10 of Ch. 18, SLA 1953 is hereby repealed and  
28 reenacted to read as follows:

29 Section 10. Any person, employer, employee, labor

1 organization, employment agency or person or persons  
2 violating this Act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and,  
3 upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not to  
4 exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment  
5 in the federal jail for a period not to exceed 30 days, or  
6 by both such fine and imprisonment.
