5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to require all persons, business
7 associations, and legal entities furnishing
8 or bidding to furnish contractual services,
9 materials or supplies to the Territorial
10 Government or any agency thereof, or to any
11 public utility district, school district, or
12 municipality of the first, second, or third
13 class, to be licensed under the Alaska Busi-
14 ness License Act; amending Sec. 3 of Art IV,
15 Ch. 82, SLA 1955 as amended; amending Sec.
16 49-2-21, ACLA 1949 as amended by Ch. 75, SLA
17 1949 and Ch. 21, SLA 1951 and Ch. 105, SLA
18 1953 as hereafter amended, by adding a new
19 paragraph thereto; amending Sec. 16-1-35,
20 ACLA 1949, as amended by Chs. 38, 91 and 92,
21 SLA 1949, Chs. 47 and 61, SLA 1951, Chs. 27,
22 28, 44, 118, and 121, SLA 1953, and Chs. 28,
23 51, and 67, SLA 1955, by adding a new para-
24 graph at the end thereof; amending Sec. 16-
25 2-5, ACLA 1949 as amended by Chs. 92 and 118,
26 SLA 1953, by adding a new paragraph at the
27 end thereof; amending Sec. 5 of Ch. 46, SLA
28 1949; and amending Ch. 3 of Title 37, ACLA
29 1949 as amended by Chs. 52 and 61, SLA 1949,

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

5 Section 1. Sec. 3 of Art. IV, Ch. 82, SLA 1955, as amended,
6 is hereby amended by adding the following subsection (5) thereto:

7 (5) Every person, business association or legal entity,
8 except an agency of the federal, territorial, or local govern-
9 ment, furnishing, or bidding to furnish, contractual services,
10 materials or supplies shall have a valid Alaska Business
11 License. All sealed bids and invoices for the furnishing of
12 such services, materials or supplies shall contain the serial
13 number of the vendor's Alaska Business License, the type of
14 business for which the license was issued, and the date of
15 issuance. No contract shall be awarded, nor shall any invoice
16 be paid upon any bid or invoice that does not contain such
17 information, or upon the bid or invoice of any person or firm
18 which does not have a valid Alaska Business License.

19 Sec. 2. Sec. 49-2-21, ACLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 75,
20 SLA 1949 and Ch. 21, SLA 1951 and Ch. 105, SLA 1953, as amended,
21 is hereby amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

22 Every person, business association or legal entity,
23 except an agency of the federal, territorial, or local govern-
24 ment, furnishing, or bidding to furnish, contractual services,
25 materials or supplies to any public utility district shall
26 have a valid Alaska Business License. All sealed bids and
27 invoices for the furnishing of such services, materials or
28 supplies shall contain the serial number of the vendor's
29 Alaska Business License, the type of business for which the

1 license was issued, and the date of issuance. No contract
2 shall be awarded, nor shall any invoice be paid upon any bid
3 or invoice that does not contain such information, or upon
4 the bid or invoice of any person or firm which does not have
5 a valid Alaska Business License.

6 Sec. 3 Sec. 16-1-35, ACLA 1949, as amended is hereby amended.
7 by adding the following paragraph at the end thereof:

8 Every person, business association or legal entity,
9 except an agency of federal, territorial, or local government,
10 furnishing, or bidding to furnish, contractual services,
11 materials or supplies to any municipality of the first class
12 shall have a valid Alaska Business License. All sealed bids
13 and invoices for the furnishing of such services, materials
14 or supplies shall contain the serial number of the vendor's
15 Alaska Business License, the type of business for which the
16 license was issued, and the date of issuance. No contract
17 shall be awarded, nor shall any invoice be paid upon any bid
18 or invoice that does not contain such information, or upon
19 the bid or invoice of any person or firm which does not have
20 a valid Alaska Business License.

21 Sec. 4. Sec. 16-2-5, ACLA 1949, as amended, is hereby
22 amended by adding the following paragraph at the end thereof:

23 Every person, business association or legal entity,
24 except an agency of the federal, territorial, or local govern-
25 ment, furnishing, or bidding to furnish, contractual services,
26 materials or supplies to any municipality of the second class
27 shall have a valid Alaska Business License. All sealed bids
28 and invoices for the furnishing of such services, materials
29 or supplies shall contain the serial number of the vendor's

1 Alaska Business License, the type of business for which the
2 license was issued, and the date of issuance. No contract
3 shall be awarded, nor shall any invoice be paid upon any bid
4 or invoice of any person or firm which does not have a valid
5 Alaska Business License.

6 Sec. 5. Sec. 5 of Ch. 46, SLA 1949, is hereby amended to
7 read as follows:

8 Section 5. The trustees of such municipal corporation
9 of the third class shall have the same powers as those con-
10 ferred by Section 16-2-5, ACLA 1949, as may be amended here-
11 after, upon trustees of municipalities of the second class.

12 Sec. 6. Ch. 3 of Title 37, ACLA 1949, as amended, is hereby
13 amended by adding a new Article VI thereto to read as follows:

14 ARTICLE VI

15 GENERAL PURCHASING REQUIREMENTS

16 Sec. 37-3-71. BIDS AND PURCHASES. Every person,
17 business association or legal entity, except an agency of
18 the federal, territorial, or local government, furnishing,
19 or bidding to furnish, contractual services, materials or
20 supplies to any school districts shall have a valid Alaska
21 Business License. All sealed bids and invoices for the
22 furnishing of such services, materials or supplies shall
23 contain the serial number of the vender's Alaska Business
24 License, the type of business for which the license was
25 issued, and the date of issuance. No contract shall be
26 awarded, nor shall any invoice be paid upon any bid or invoice
27 that does not contain such information, or upon the bid or
28 invoice of any person or firm which does not have a valid
29 Alaska Business License.
