5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the construction of a
7 juvenile correctional institution; designat-
8 ing the Board of Juvenile Institutions as
9 the administering agency; designating minors
10 who shall be placed in the institution and
11 authorizing the Board to receive them;
12 authorizing receipt of grants-in-aid and
13 gifts for use in construction; declaring
14 purpose and nature of training; and author-
15 izing appropriation."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

17 Section 1. CONSTRUCTION OF INSTITUTION. The Board of Juven-
18 ile Institutions is hereby authorized to secure site and construct
19 a juvenile correctional institution at such place in the Territory
20 of Alaska as it shall select as most suitable.

21 Sec. 2. ADMINISTRATION; COST THEREOF. The Board of Juvenile
22 Institutions shall have through its Director full responsibility
23 for the administration and operation of the juvenile correctional
24 institution and shall employ staff, formulate general policies,
25 adopt rules and regulations, establish personnel standards and
26 perform such other functions not inconsistent with the purpose
27 and intent of this Act. The cost of operating the institution
28 shall be met with funds appropriated to the Board.

29 Sec. 3. MINORS PLACED IN INSTITUTION: AUTHORITY OF BOARD

1 TO RECEIVE MINORS. Only minors adjudged to be juvenile delinquents
2 by a court of competent jurisdiction shall be placed in the
3 institution. The Board is hereby authorized to receive into its
4 custody minors who are so adjudged and to place said minors in
5 the institution for care and training.

6 Sec. 4. ACCEPTANCE BY BOARD OF GRANTS-IN-AID AND GIFTS. The
7 Board, through its Director, is hereby authorized to accept all
8 grants-in-aid and gifts of real or personal property from any
9 source whatsoever to be used in the construction of said institution.

-- 10 Sec. 5. TRAINING OF MINORS: PURPOSE AND NATURE. The institu-
11 tion shall provide such training in the fields of conduct and
12 morals, vocational and industrial skills, and academic schooling,
13 as will achieve character reformation and vocational adequacy,
14 and promote the return of minors held therein to a useful life
15 in society.

16 Sec. 6. APPROPRIATION. Funds to carry out the provisions
17 of this Act may be appropriated in the General Appropriation
18 Bill of the Alaska Legislature.
