Your Memorialist, the Senate of the Territory of Alaska,

in Twenty-third Session assembled, respectfully represents:

WHEREAS, the region between Klawock and Hollis, on Prince
13 of Wales Island, Alaska, is a source of great potential mineral
14 and timber wealth; and

15

WHEREAS, the Harris River and Klawock Lake on said Prince
16 of Wales Island furnish excellent recreational facilities; and

17

WHEREAS, the Ketchikan Pulp Company has already commenced
18 the construction of a road leading from Hollis to the west; and

19

WHEREAS, the construction of a road between Klawock and
20 Hollis will greatly aid the economic development of the villages
21 of Klawock, Hidsburg, and Craig on the western coast of Prince
22 of Wales Island; and

WHEREAS, the construction of such a road would enable at
24 least five logging camps on said western coast to transport logs
25 overland from their sites to Hollis, thereby obviating the neces-
26 sity of moving said logs by raft around the hazardous Cape Chacon
27 and Clarence Strait; and

WHEREAS, such a road would also permit the fishing fleets
29 to transport their catches overland from the western coast to

1 Hollis;

2 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialist prays that the construc-
3 tion of a road between Klawock and Hollis, Alaska, be accorded
4 a high priority in the planning and development of the Alaska
5 road system.
