Your Memorialist, the Senate of the Territory of Alaska, in

10 Twenty-Third Regular Session assembled, respectfully submits that:

WHEREAS, at the present time there is no linking surface

12

transportation connecting the city of Cordova, Alaska, with the

13

Alaska highway system and the residents of Cordova are in dire

14

need of such transportation; and

15

WHEREAS, completion of the partially constructed Copper

16

River Highway, would provide such a connection and would contri-

17

bute greatly to the present and future economic growth and pros-

18

perity of the residents of Cordova and the towns and villages

19

situated along the Copper River, as well as all the residents of

20

Alaska;

NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialist, the Senate of the Terri-

22

tory of Alaska, in Twenty-Third Regular Session assembled,

23

respectfully urges that immediate completion of the Copper

24

River Highway be approved and that the necessary funds for that

25

purpose be designated for expenditure during the next construc-

tion period.
