IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-THIRD SESSION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, many foreign vehicles enter the Territory of Alaska
7 each year over the Alaska Highway, or are shipped into the Terri-
8 tory by water transportation for use in Alaska; and

WHEREAS, many such vehicles in the Territory bear license
10 plates of states and jurisdictions other than Alaska; and

WHEREAS, all owners of such vehicles who are gainfully em-
12 ployed in the Territory are required by law to immediately obtain
13 an Alaska license and title for their vehicles; and

WHEREAS, it is also incumbent by law upon all such owners
15 who remain in Alaska for a period of 90 days or more to obtain
16 such license; and

WHEREAS, although the Department of Territorial Police has
18 caused such owners to obtain the necessary Alaska plates,
19 notwithstanding their efforts, many vehicle owners still evade
20 this Alaska law;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Territory
22 of Alaska, in Twenty-Third Session assembled, that the Department
23 of Territorial Police is directed to further increase its dili-
24 gence and efforts in enforcing the laws pertaining to licensure
25 and registration of foreign vehicles and to apprehend and pro-
26 secute all violators so that all such vehicle owners will bear
27 the common responsibility of providing revenues to the Territory,
