6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to prohibit employment of females
7 for certain purposes in connection with the
8 sale of intoxicating liquors and providing
9 penalties."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. No female person shall be employed by or associa-
12 ted in any manner with the holder or operator of any liquor dis-
13 pensary, club, restaurant, or common carrier dispensary license
14 issued under the laws of the State of Alaska, to solicit, entice
15 or encourage the purchase by patrons of any such licensed premises
16 of alcoholic beverages upon a rebate, percentage, or share the
17 profit basis; nor shall any such female person receive any salary
18 or other compensation from any person for the solicitation, entice-
19 ment, or encouragement of the purchase of alcoholic beverages as
20 hereinabove set forth.

21 Sec. 2. Any female person or the holder or operator of any
22 liquor dispensary, club, restaurant, or common carrier dispensary
23 license violating the provisions of this Act shall be guilty of a
24 misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than
25 \$100.00 or more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment for not more than
26 sixty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
