5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating the Governor's Committee
7 on Local Hire; setting qualifications of
8 members; establishing duties of the
9 Committee; calling for a report to the
10 Governor; setting an expiration date; and
11 making provision for an appropriation
12 to finance the activities of the Committee."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

14 Section 1. A committee to be known as "The Governor's
15 Committee on Local Hire" is hereby created. The Governor shall
16 serve as an ex-officio member of the committee, and members
17 shall be chosen by the Governor as follows:

18 (a) Two members from the First State Legislature,
19 one to be chosen from the House of Representatives and one from
20 the Senate;

21 (b) Two persons representative of Alaskan labor and
22 trade groups;

23 (c) Two persons representative of industry and
24 management in Alaska;

25 (d) Two residents of Alaska from the general public
26 who shall be considered public members.

27 Sec. 2. The Committee created by this Act shall be directly
28 accountable to the Governor and shall have the following duties:

29 (a) To carefully investigate and evaluate the

1 comparative extent of resident and non-resident hiring in Alaska
2 by companies under contract to the Federal government and other
3 employers of all types, and to attempt to ascertain if there are
4 problems and conflicts in the matter of resident, non-resident
5 hiring, and the extent of and possible solutions to such conflicts
6 and problems.

7 (b) To report its findings to the Governor at least
8 thirty days before the convening of the 1960 Session of the
9 Legislature.

10 Sec. 3. The Committee shall be an agent of the Governor
11 and shall have, at his direction, the powers of the Governor as
12 regards obtaining the cooperation of State, public and private
13 enterprises and persons in the course of the investigations
14 authorized by this Act.

15 Sec. 4. The Governor shall name one of the members
16 Chairman of the Committee and the Chairman at the direction of
17 the Governor shall call necessary meetings.

18 Sec. 5. Monies to cover per diem for members as allowed
19 by law and when actually engaged in the duties set out in this
20 Act, for travel and other necessary expenses of the Committee
21 shall be provided in the bill setting out appropriations for the
22 activities of the Executive Branch of the State government.

23 Sec. 6. Unless otherwise provided by law, the Committee
24 as created by this Act shall cease to exist ten days after the
25 convening of the Second Session of the First State Legislature.
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
