4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating the Governor's Committee  
7 on Local Hire and Purchasing; setting  
8 qualifications of members; establishing  
9 duties of the Committee; calling for a  
10 report to the Governor; setting an ex-  
11 piration date; and making provision for an  
12 appropriation to finance the activities  
13 of the Committee."

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

15 Section 1. A committee to be known as "The Governor's  
16 Committee on Local Hire and Purchasing" is hereby created. The  
17 Governor shall serve as an ex-officio member of the committee,  
18 and members shall be chosen by the Governor as follows:

19 (a) Two members from the First State Legislature,  
20 one to be chosen from the House of Representatives and one from  
21 the Senate;

22 (b) Two persons representative of Alaskan labor and  
23 trade groups;

24 (c) Two persons representative of industry and  
25 management in Alaska;

26 (d) Two residents of Alaska from the general public  
27 who shall be considered public members.

28 Sec. 2. The Committee created by this Act shall be directly  
29 accountable to the Governor and shall have the following duties:

1 (a) To carefully investigate and evaluate the  
2 comparative extent of resident and non-resident hiring in Alaska  
3 by companies under contract to the Federal Government and other  
4 employers of all types, and to attempt to ascertain if there are  
5 problems and conflicts in the matter of resident, non-resident  
6 hiring, and the extent of and possible solutions to such conflicts  
7 and problems.

8 (b) To investigate and evaluate carefully the extent  
9 of out-of-state purchases of materials and products which are  
10 available for purchase within the State, and to further investi-  
11 gate the use of materials and products that have utilized  
12 Alaskan labor or materials in their manufacture, production or  
13 fabrication.

14 (c) To report its findings to the Governor at least  
15 30 days before the convening of the 1960 session of the Legis-  
16 lature.

17 (d) The foregoing enumeration of duties shall not be  
18 exclusive; and the committee shall have such additional necessary  
19 and related duties, powers, functions and such additional areas  
20 of inquiry as may be designated by the Governor.

21 Sec. 3. The Committee shall be an agent of the Governor  
22 and shall have, at his direction, the powers of the Governor as  
23 regards obtaining the cooperation of State, public and private  
24 enterprises and persons in the course of the investigations  
25 authorized by this Act.

26 Sec. 4. The Governor shall name one of the members Chairman  
27 of the committee and the Chairman at the direction of the Governor  
28 shall call necessary meetings.

29 Sec. 5. Monies to cover per diem for members as allowed by

1 law and when actually engaged in the duties set out in this Act,  
2 for travel and other necessary expenses of the Committee shall be  
3 provided in the bill setting out appropriations for the activities  
4 of the Executive Branch of the State government.

5 Sec. 6. Unless otherwise provided by law, the Committee  
6 as created by this Act shall cease to exist ten days after the  
7 convening of the Second Session of the First State Legislature.

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
