FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to appropriate funds for the payment of bounty deficiencies; to authorize the Treasurer to waive the provisions of Sec. 33-3-113, ACLA 1949, relative to bounty claims, and setting an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are hereby appropriated for the purposes hereinafter specified, to-wit:

BOUNTY CLAIMS: DEFICIENCIES	
Wolf and coyote claims, including uncertified claims	\$65,000.00
Wolverine claims, including uncertified claims	8,500.00
Hair seal claims	70,000.00
TOTAL	\$143,500.00

Sec. 2. The Treasurer is hereby authorized to approve claims for bounties heretofore not paid for failure to present same in strict conformity with law.

Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
