6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to repeal of certain  
7 Federal laws incorporated in the Alaska Code  
8 relating to the legislative department and  
9 processes; repealing Sec. 4-1-1 through and  
10 including Sec. 4-1-8, Sec. 4-2-1 through and  
11 including Sec. 4-2-6, Sec. 4-2-8, Sec. 4-3-1  
12 through and including Sec. 4-3-7, Sec. 4-6-1  
13 through and including Sec. 4-6-3, Sec.  
14 11-1-3, Sec. 37-1-1, Sec. 38-5-1, Sec.  
15 38-8-1, Sec. 38-8-2, Sec. 38-8-4, Sec.  
16 48-1-1, and Sec. 48-1-2, ACLA 1949; and  
17 setting an effective date."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

19 Section 1. DECLARATION OF INTENT. The Organic Act (37 Stat.  
20 512; see 48 U.S.C. 24), as amended, as well as other Federal laws  
21 relating to the Territorial legislative departments and processes,  
22 have been incorporated into the Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated  
23 1949 and, by virtue of the Constitution of the State of Alaska,  
24 such prior Territorial laws remain in effect until repealed, there-  
25 by raising a conflict between the said Constitution and such prior  
26 incorporated laws; it is accordingly declared to be the intent  
27 and purpose of this Act to repeal all portions of the said Organic  
28 Act and certain other Federal statutes as incorporated into the  
29 laws of Alaska relating to the legislative departments and

1 processes in order to remove such conflict.

2 Sec. 2. REPEALER. Sec. 4-1-1 through and including Sec.  
3 4-1-8, Sec. 4-2-1 through and including Sec. 4-2-6, Sec. 4-2-8,  
4 Sec. 4-3-1 through and including Sec. 4-3-7, Sec. 4-6-1 through  
5 and including Sec. 4-6-3, Sec. 11-3-1, Sec. 37-1-1, Sec. 38-5-1,  
6 Sec. 38-8-1, Sec. 38-8-2, Sec. 38-8-4, Sec. 48-1-1 and Sec.  
7 48-1-2, ACLA 1949 are hereby repealed.

8 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall become effective  
9 immediately upon its passage and approval, or upon its becoming  
10 law without such approval.
