6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to repeal of certain
7 Federal laws incorporated in the Alaska Code
8 relating to the legislative department and
9 repealing Sec. 4-1-1 through and including
10 Sec. 4-1-8, Sec. 4-2-1 except the clause
11 beginning with the word "all" in line 29 of
12 said section 4-2-1 and ending with the semi-
13 colon on line 31 thereof, through and includ-
14 ing Sec. 4-2-6, Sec. 4-2-8, Sec. 4-3-1
15 through and including Sec. 4-3-7, Sec. 4-6-1
16 through and including Sec. 4-6-4, Sec. 11-3-
17 1, Sec. 37-1-1, Sec. 38-5-1, Sec. 38-8-1,
18 Sec. 38-8-2, Sec. 38-8-3, Sec. 38-8-4, Sec.
19 48-1-1, and Sec. 48-1-2, ACLA 1949; and pro-
20 viding for an effective date."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

22 Section 1. DECLARATION OF INTENT. The Organic Act (37 Stat.
23 512; see 48 U.S.C. 24), as amended, as well as other Federal laws
24 relating to the Territorial legislative departments and processes,
25 have been incorporated into the Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated
26 1949 and, by virtue of the Constitution of the State of Alaska,
27 such prior Territorial laws remain in effect until repealed, there-
28 by raising a conflict between the said Constitution and such prior
29 incorporated laws; it is accordingly declared to be the intent

1 and purpose of this Act to repeal certain portions of the said
2 Organic Act and certain other Federal statutes as incorporated
3 into the laws of Alaska relating to the legislative departments
4 in order to remove such conflict.

5 Sec. 2. REPEALER. Sec. 4-1-1 through and including Sec.
6 4-1-3, Sec. 4-2-1 except the clause beginning with the word "all"
7 in line 29 of said section 4-2-1 and ending with the semi-colon on
8 line 31 thereof, through and including Sec. 4-2-6, Sec. 4-2-8, Sec.
9 4-3-1 through and including Sec. 4-3-7, Sec. 4-6-1 through and in-
10 cluding Sec. 4-6-4, Sec. 11-3-1, Sec. 37-1-1, Sec. 38-5-1, Sec. 38-
11 8-1, Sec. 38-8-2, Sec. 38-8-3, Sec. 38-8-4, Sec. 48-1-1 and Sec.
12 48-1-2, ACLA 1949 are hereby repealed.

13 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall become effective
14 immediately upon its passage and approval, or upon its becoming
15 law without such approval.
